# ANNUAL ZEB \$2,500 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

**JIM ZEBHAZY** served as the executive director of the Young American Bowling Alliance from October of 1996 through December 2004, when the organization merged with the American Bowling Congress, Women's International Bowling Congress and USA Bowling to form the United States Bowling Congress. Under Zebehazy's leadership, YABA successfully implemented new programs and services, including a national magazine for youth bowlers, the Junior Gold program and what is now known as the USBC Junior Gold Championships.

This scholarship is awarded annually to one USBC Youth member.

**THE ANNUAL ZEB SCHOLARSHIP** is awarded to a USBC Youth member who achieves academic success and gives back to his/her community through service. One person will be selected to receive a \$2,500 scholarship, which will be managed through the SMART program. The Annual Zeb Scholarship will be formally presented at the USBC Junior Gold Championships award ceremony. USBC will pay travel and hotel expenses for the

winner and one parent/guardian to attend the award ceremony. The selection is based on the candidate's grades, academic and community involvement, letters of reference and essay.

The Annual Zeb Scholarship commemorates the dedication and enthusiasm for youth bowling exemplified by Jim Zebehazy.

**ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS**

1. Be in junior or senior year of high school
2. Be a USBC Youth member in good standing
3. Have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
4. Completed application
5. Include at least two letters of reference (by a teacher, principal, employer, etc.)
6. Include an official or unofficial school transcript
7. Return all completed documentation and application to USBC post-marked no later than **DECEMBER 1, 2012**. (Partial or incomplete applications will not be accepted)
