CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: November 14, 2011

THIS TOURNAMENT IS A NORTH POINTE JUNIOR GOLD EVENT. There is no additional fee charged to bowl this event, but you must be a USBC Junior Gold Program Member to enter. The highest Scratch six games total bowled in the qualifier on Sunday Nov. 20, 2011 at 1:30 for either two boys and/or two girls will be seeded to the NORTH POINTE Junior Gold Championship. YOU MUST BE ELIGIBLE FOR A JUNIOR GOLD MEMBERSHIP CARD AT TIME OF CHECK IN.

NEW MEXICO PEPSI USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES AT STATE LEVEL

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association. Entrants holding only Basic Membership must pay state dues of \$.50 to be eligible to bowl in this tournament.

Current membership card must be presented at check-in.
- 2. ENTERING AVERAGES:** Average shall be the highest current average as of October 31, 2011, with a minimum of 12 games bowled. Averages must be verified by an **Individual Record Sheet** and signed by an adult league official or coach. If 12 games have not been bowled by October 31, 2011, then the book average from 2010-2011 will be used if neither one of these applies then an **Individual Record Sheet** showing the 12 game averages by November 19, 2011 must accompany the bowler to the tournament verifying the 12 game averages at the time of competition. If none of these apply then the bowler will bowl scratch.
- 3. PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Award-Prize Fund fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in the form of Scholarships and awards, and monies will be deposited in the bowlers name with the SMART Program within 30 days from the end of the tournament. Symbolic awards will be given to at least the top three finishers in each division. Scholarships will be given in at least 1:10 ratio of participation in each Division. First place winners in the **12 and Over Scratch Divisions** will receive an automatic entry in the NORTH POINTE Junior Gold Championships, to be held on July 14-20, 2012, in Indianapolis, IN and they will receive partial travel reimbursement from NMUSBC. **The advancers must be Junior Gold Program members, or be eligible and purchase a membership at the championships. There is no requirement to be a Junior Gold Program member to enter the scratch division at the state level.** If the winner is not eligible for the championships, he/she will still retain all awards from the state level, but the next eligible bowler will receive the berth to the NORTH POINTE Junior Gold Championships. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the National Finals or failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. The decision to go or not must be made within 3 months after the State Pepsi Finals and the Tournament Director needs to be informed with the decision.
- 4.** The NMUSBC Tournament Committee shall determine all matters not covered by these rules. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
- 5. CLASSIFIED DIVISIONS:** Competition will be conducted in the following Six (6) Divisions: 11 and Under Boys' Handicap; 11 and Under Girls' Handicap; 12 and Over Boys' Handicap; 12 and Over Girls' Handicap; 12 and Over Boys' Scratch; and 12 and Over Girls' Scratch. **Bowlers with an average of 211 or higher must compete in the scratch division. Please note these divisions are based on ages as of August 1, 2011.** Three games will be bowled in the 11 and Under Division. Six games will be bowled in the 12 and Over Age Division, three games will be bowled and then bowlers will move one pair of lanes to the right for their second three game series. The Scratch Division bowlers will have a random rotation determined by the Tournament Director at the time they bowl, also **THE SCRATCH DIVISION WILL BE BOWLED ON A SPORT SHOT.** There is no qualifying in your local leagues and all certified bowlers in New Mexico may participate, if they meet the average requirements in **Rule 2.**
- 6. HANDICAP:** 100% of the difference between the bowlers's average and 210.
- 7. ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** **Entries close Midnight November 14, 2011 (11/14/2011)** Name, Address, and telephone numbers of qualifiers, entry fee and **Individual Record Sheet Dated October 31, 2011** or closest league date applicable must accompany the entry. **ALL THREE ITEMS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO HAVE A LEGAL ENTRY,** without **FORM, FEE, & INDIVIDUAL RECORD SHEET,** entry will not be processed and will be returned for proper papers and this may cause a delay in scheduling your entry. **ENTRIES WILL BE PROCESSED ON A FIRST COME BASIS, SO GET THEM IN EARLY TO GET THE SQUAD TIME YOU WANT.**
- 8. DRESS CODE: USBC Rule 301b will apply.** Members of the Board of Directors of NMUSBC, as sponsors of this Championship Tournament, request that all bowlers wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament; Slacks, Skirts or walking shorts to the knee and official USBC jerseys are preferred, bowling shirts or blouses will be

allowed. **NO HATS. UNSUITABLE ATTIRE;** Tank tops, workout attire (i.e. Spandex, sweatpants), Short Shorts (if a bowlers fingers are below the hemline, the Shorts are considered too short and not suitable.), Bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics. Bowlers shall wear authorized bowling shoes. **VIOLATIONS: Entrants will be required to change into suitable attire. Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl.** Tournament management reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired without recourse. Attire needed for medical reasons must be discussed with tournament management prior to the tournament.

9. Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants). This is a non-smoking event. No tobacco or alcohol products will be allowed by participants or spectators during the tournament. **Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the settee area.** There will be **NO** use of electronic devices (video games, radios, cell phone, CD Players, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event.

10. PROTEST: In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules, the protest must be filed in writing to tournament management no later than seventy two (72) hours after completion of event **USBC Rule 329.** In case of scoring errors they should be reported immediately upon discovery.

11. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed will be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will get a zero for that frame.

12. Ties to determine position standings for advancement to the NORTH POINTE Junior Gold National Finals shall be broken by a one game roll-off after the tournament is finished on the last day of the Tournament. If a tie still exists, it will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off plus 1/10 of handicap per frame if applicable.
