



2011 – 2012 PEPSI USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS SECTIONAL RULES & FORMAT FOR THE STATE OF ALABAMA

1. This tournament is certified (Cert. # 4498) by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC Youth rules. Only USBC Youth members may participate.
2. League level qualifying dates are November 7 – 21, 2011 and January 2 – 23, 2012. Advancement from league is a one-time entry. If an individual who qualified cannot participate in this competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish in previous competition.
3. Advancement ratio from league competition to sectional competition is a least one (1) for every two (2) entries per division, per league, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties, for 11 & under boys and girls and 12 & above boys and girls handicap. Advancement ratio from league competition to sectional competition is at least one (1) for every one (1) entry per division, per league, for 12 & above boys and girls scratch. The advancement ratio shall be applied uniformly to all eligible divisions.
4. Advancers out of the league level must **remain** in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state zone the bowler must declare one state zone to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state zone will result in automatic disqualification.
5. Competition will take place at the Bowling Centers in the cities listed below on the dates and times indicated.

6. Entry closing date is Monday, February 6, 2012. Qualifiers' name, address, telephone number, date of birth and all entrants' tournament entry fees and forms must be submitted by this date to sectional tournament director.
7. Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions. These divisions are based on the participant's age as of August 1, 2011. 11 & under boys and girls handicap, 12 & above boys and girls handicap and 12 & above boys and girls scratch.
8. The tournament format shall be:

Divisions in ages 11 & under will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes.
 Divisions in ages 12 & above will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes.

9. Entry Fee:

10. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Please see Rule #301b. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No short-shorts (shorts must be knee-length), no backless blouses or dresses, no halter tops or tank tops, no torn, baggy or sagging jeans, no obscene T-shirts, or hats will be worn during the tournament. No playing of handheld or any type of video games, and no listening of portable cassette/disc players or radios during the tournament. No cell phones. The Tournament Director will make all decisions as far as the dress code.

NO SMOKING PERMITTED BY USBC YOUTH PARTICIPANTS. PARENTS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS NEEDING TO SMOKE, MUST DO SO IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

11. No substitutes will be permitted; however, a replacement qualifier may be used for bowlers 15 minutes prior to the squad time as stated in Rule #2. Replacements must be from same league, window, and division as the replaced/absent bowler based on standings.
12. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice.
13. If no substitution has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it is their turn shall be credited with a zero for each frame missed.

14. Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average, minimum of 12 games, as of January 23, 2012. Bowlers without a minimum of 12 games as of January 23, 2012 will use their average as of tournament date, provided they have 12 games. Bowlers without an established average shall bowl scratch. **Averages must be verified by a standing sheet.**
15. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 210.
16. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
17. If there is a tie at the sectional competition a 1 game roll-off will be held. Should the tie still exist, it will be broken by an additional 9th and 10th frame roll-off, plus 1/10th of handicap per frame where applicable. (refer to Rule 326a)
18. Claims of errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
19. Advancement ratio from Sectional level to the next competition level (State) is at least one (1) for every three (3) entries per division, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties for 11 & under boys & girls handicap and 12 & above boys & girls handicap. Advancement ratio from Sectional level to the next competition level is least one (1) for every two (2) entries per division for the 12 & above boys and girls scratch. In all cases at least one (1) individual per division shall advance. The advancement ratio shall be applied uniformly to all eligible divisions.
20. The next level of competition for the **11 & under boys and girls handicap** will take place on **Saturday, May 5, 2012 at 1:00 pm** at

The top 6 in each division of the 12 & above will return at 4:30 pm to bowl a 6-game league schedule with a position round. The Champions will be the bowler with the highest total score from the 6 games bowled.

The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Committee reserves the right to accept and reject any participant.

2011 – 2012 PEPSI USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES AND FORMAT FOR ALABAMA STATE LEVEL

1. This tournament is certified (Cert. # 4498) by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by the USBC Youth rules.
2. State level competition date is May 5, 2012. Advancement from Sectional Level to State Level is a one-time entry. If an individual who qualified cannot participate in the State competition, replacement will be eligible based on order of finish in previous Sectional competition.
3. Advancement ratio from Sectional competition to the State competition is at least one (1) for every three (3) entries per division, or major fraction thereof, including last place ties for 11 & under boys and girls handicap and 12 & above boys and girls handicap. Advancement ratio from Sectional competition to the State competition is at least one (1) for every one (2) per division or major fraction thereof, including last place ties for the 12 & above boys and girls scratch. In all cases at least one (1) person per division shall advance.
4. Entry closing date is Monday, March 26, 2012. Qualifier's name, address, telephone number, and date of birth must be submitted to the state tournament director by this date.
5. Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions, based on their age of August 1, 2011: Boys and girls Handicap for ages 11 & under and 12 & above and a Scratch division for boys and girls age 12 & above.

Will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes. Total pinfall plus handicap where applicable will determine the top 6. **Squad Time - 9:30 am**

At 4:30 pm the top 6 in the 12 & above divisions will come back and bowl 6 games using a 6-team league schedule with a position round for game 6. Pinfall from previous games will be dropped. Total pinfall plus handicap (where applicable) will determine the champions.

7. Entry fee was included in the Sectional fees. Awards and Scholarship fee shall be returned 100%. All Scholarships held in Smart Program (SMART Acct. # 8508) Contact SMART 1-800-513-2695 ext. 8292).

Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Please see Rule #301b. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Collared Shirts or the "Youth Member Shirts" with slacks; capris will be accepted for girls as long as they are not jean capris. NO JEANS OR SHORTS ALLOWED! No hats or caps. Knee length dresses are okay for girls. No playing of handheld or any type of video games, and no listening of portable cassette/disc players or radios during the tournament. No Cell Phones. The Tournament Director will make all decisions regarding the dress code.

NO SMOKING PERMITTED BY USBC YOUTH PARTICIPANTS. PARENTS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS NEEDING TO SMOKE MUST DO SO IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS.

8. No substitutes will be permitted, however; replacements may be used for bowlers not present 15 minutes prior to squad time as stated in Rule 2.
9. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes practice on their starting lanes.
10. If no substitution has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero for that frame.

11. Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average, minimum of 12 games, as of January 23, 2012. Bowlers without a 12 game average as of January 23, 2012, can use their average as of Sectional Tournament date, provided they had 12 games. Bowlers without an established average will bowl scratch. **Averages must be verified with a standing sheet.**
12. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 210.
13. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the settee area.
14. Ties will be broken by a 1 game roll-off plus handicap (were applicable). Should a tie still exist, it will be broken by a 9th & 10th frame roll-off, plus 1/10th of the bowler's handicap per frame (where applicable) (Rule 326A).
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. The tournament director shall decide upon questionable errors. All other protest must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
16. Symbolic Awards will be given as follows:
 - Top 6 in 12 & above Divisions 1st Place – A plaque, all others a certificate
 - Top 3 11 & under Division 1st Place – A plaque, all others a certificate
17. Scholarships will be awarded as follows in each division:
 - 1st Place - \$ 500.00 2nd Place - \$ 300.00 3rd Place - \$ 200.00.
18. The first place winners and runners-up of the 12 and above Girls and Boys Scratch Divisions will advance to the 2012 USBC North Pointe Junior Gold Championships on July 14-20, 2012 in Indianapolis, IN. They must be a USBC Junior Gold member to advance or purchase a USBC Junior Gold membership prior to the championships. USBC will waive the \$200 entry fee for these athletes. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All U.S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team USA 2013 to represent the United States in national and international competition.
19. The first place winners in the 12 and above Handicap Divisions will receive a paid entry into the 2012 USBC Youth Open Championship Tournament to be held in Indianapolis, IN on July 12-29, 2012. (\$100.00 fee covers all events into the tournament)
20. Advancers must agree to bowl in the Championship Tournaments, or failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacement will be selected based on the order of placement in their division at

the State level. **If the advancer decides not to attend the International finals, the State Scholarship won may be withdrawn and all monies received must be return. This decision will be made by the State Tournament Committee.**

21. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Alabama Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Committee and the National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
