All collegiate bowlers can attempt to qualify for the Intercollegiate Singles Championships through one of the four sectional qualifiers. Bowlers at each sectional location will bowl six games of qualifying and a total of 24 men and 16 women will advance to the national finals. At each sectional, the top four men and top four women advance; the additional eight men's spots will be based on the size of the field at each location. Airfare, hotel, transportation and meals for each national finalist will be paid by USBC.

- USBC Collegiate member for the 2011-12 season, or pay a non-member participation fee of \$25.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale). Note: participants are not required to be a member of an intercollegiate bowling team.
