Re: 2010 ISC & ITC Sectional Qualifier Points of Emphasis

Coaches Meeting Friday, March 12, 2010

We request that all schools have representation at the coaches meeting on Friday night. If you are unable to attend this meeting you must notify your sectional manager.

Eligibility Forms and Rules Signoff Form

All eligibility and Rules Signoff forms must be turned in to the Sectional Tournament Manager at the coaches meeting on Friday, March 12, 2010. The form must be completed by the Registrars office and stamped with the school seal. In the event that a school encounters an issue with obtaining eligibility forms from their Registrars Office, the coach must contact USBC Collegiate prior to Monday, March 8, 2010. Notification after this date (including on-site at Sectionals) will not be accepted.

Dress Code changes

Intercollegiate Singles Championship (ISC):

The Intercollegiate Singles Championship Qualifying does require the participant to meet all USBC Collegiate Dress Code Rules, excluding team shirt lettering and matching team uniforms. If a player is not in compliance, he/she is not allowed to participate. Jersey style shirts are now acceptable only if the screened item on the shirtfront chest is the school logo and or registered trademark of the school.

ITC Sectional Qualifier

The Intercollegiate Team Championship Qualifying has several changes in the dress code policies for this season. The changes are as follows:

1. A team or individual in violation of the dress code policies will not be able to bowl until they are in compliance with the dress code policies.
2. Mock turtlenecks are acceptable.
3. Each team members must have the school name, initials, **or registered trademark logo** in letters a minimum of one-inch high on the shirt back.
4. All athletes listed on the team roster must be in full uniform at the start of competition to be eligible for competition (i.e., sharing of shirts between athletes is not allowed).
5. Jersey style shirts are now acceptable only if the screened item on the shirtfront chest is the school logo and or registered trademark of the school.
6. Coaches are not permitted to wear sweatshirts.

Bowling Balls

No modifications can be made to the affect balance of the bowling ball (i.e. additional weight holes, modification of existing holes, etc.).

Bowling ball(s) submitted on the ITC and ITC Sectional ball card cannot be removed from the center. Any bowling ball(s) removed from the center cannot be used for the remainder of the competition.

The ball card must be submitted to tournament management prior to practice the day of competition.

Competition Schedule

Please note that the Academic All-American award recipients following the competition break on Sunday. We would like to request that all teams return promptly from the competition break.

Ineligible Players

Teams will be disqualified from competition for the use of an ineligible player.

Lane Courtesy

There will be one-lane courtesy at all sectional sites.
