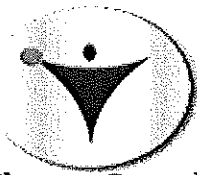

IIRC Gold Challenge

Tournament Rules:

1. Tournament will be certified through the USBC (#) and be a scratch event.
2. The USBC Playing Rules and Junior Gold Program rules will apply.
3. All participants must possess a current Junior Gold membership to compete at this event.
4. Non-Junior Gold members must purchase a Junior Gold membership [\$30] prior to the start of the tournament. Junior Gold membership is subject to the following eligibility requirements:
 - a. Females must have a verifiable USBC certified league average [minimum of 21 games bowled] of 150 or higher within the current or previous season.
 - b. Males must have a verifiable USBC certified league average [minimum of 21 games bowled] of 175 or higher within the current or previous season.
 - c. Must be a USBC certified member in good standing.
5. Tournament will be held on May 23, 2010. There will be one (1) squad beginning at **8:30** AM. Bowlers will bowl 6 games across 12 lanes, moving one (1) pair to the right after each game. A USBC Sport Bowling certified lane condition will be used for this event. Winners will be determined based on total pinfall.
6. Ties: In the event of a tie for the final advancing position, a 1 game roll off will be held immediately after qualifying.
7. Participants bowl at their own risk.
8. **Tournament Entry Fees:**

Tournament fees shall be \$55. At the conclusion of the event, all players will receive a tour of the IIRC and one (1) youth pass to the USBC Hall of Fame to be used that day. Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to **USBC Junior Gold**.
9. Tournament will use an advancement ratio of 1: 5 or major fraction thereof. There must be a minimum of four (4) female and five (5) male Junior Gold members in a division to advance a player to the USBC Junior Gold Championships. Participants in this event will be competing for spots in the 2010 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Indianapolis, IN.
 - a. Tournament Check-In begins at 8:00 AM. Walk-ins may be accepted subject to availability.
10. Winner(s):
 - a. Tournament winner(s) will receive paid entry into the 2010 USBC Junior Gold Championships. Advancement ratio of 1: 5 or major fraction thereof. There are no other advertised prizes for this event.
 - b. Tournament winners will be solely responsible for all remaining expenses associated with participating in the USBC Junior Gold Championships to include though not be limited to, the following: transportation, hotel, food and/or any other expenses incurred.
 - c. Tournament officials shall not be responsible for any accidents or incidents while traveling to/from Indianapolis including time spent participating in USBC Junior Gold Championships activities.
11. Tournament Director reserves the right to make an interpretation and decision on any rule, discrepancy and/or conflict that might arise. Decision of the tournament director shall be final unless appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
