# Summary

- Combine Junior Gold and North Pointe Tournaments into one event
- Allows for more youth bowlers to experience the Junior Gold championships
- Allows more youth Bowlers to reap the benefits of the USBC Junior Gold membership program
- Competitive division for U15 kids
- \$250,000 in scholarships!



# USBC Junior Gold Membership

- 2010-11
  - 175 for Boys
  - 150 for Girls
  - Membership Gift
  - Gold Approach
  - \$30 Membership Fee
- 2011-12
  - No minimum average required for Junior Gold membership
  - Membership Gift
  - Gold Approach
  - BTM Digital Subscription
  - \$30 Membership Fee



# Tournament Changes: Divisions

- 2010-11
  - Boys
  - Girls
- 2011-12 \*\*\*\*
  - U15 Girls
  - U20 Girls
  - U15 Boys
  - U20 Boys

\*\*\*\* Any bowler whose birthdate is 8-1-1996 or later will participate in the U15 Division. All others will participate in the U20 Division.

**NOTE: Bowlers in the U15 division may exercise the option to participate in the U20 division by completing the NPJG Championships Opt Out Form.**



# Leagues

- 2010-11
  - 1:10 or league champions
  - 36 games
  - Half the league must be Junior gold members
  - Entire league cannot qualify
  - Must be SCRATCH competition
- 2011-12
  - 1:4 or league champions
  - 24 games
  - Half the league must be Junior gold members
  - Entire league cannot qualify
  - Must be SCRATCH competition



# Tournaments

- 2010-11
  - 1:5 Boys Only
  - 1:4 Girls Only
  - 1:4 Combined
  - Major Fraction there of applied.
- 2011-12
  - 1:4 for ALL
  - Major fraction there of still applies
  - Entries in excess of ratios
    - First non-qualifier can pay the difference to advance
      - Limited to only the first non-qualifier



# Enhanced Advancement Ratio Policy

- How does the new advancer policy work for events using the “major fraction thereof” rule?
  - Once an event has met their minimum ratio and has entries in excess of that ratio, but short of the “major fraction thereof, they have the opportunity to advance one additional entrant to the NPJG Championships. The next advancer only, will be allowed to claim a spot by funding the balance of the monies needed to pay for that spot. A detailed explanation of the policy can be found on the Junior Gold page of bowl.com.



# Enhanced Advancement Ratio Policy

- How does the new advancer policy work for events NOT using the “major fraction thereof” rule?
  - Once an event has met their minimum ratio and has entries in excess of that ratio, they have the opportunity to advance one additional entrant to the NPJG Championships. The next advancer only, will be allowed to claim a spot by funding the balance of the monies needed to pay for that spot. A detailed explanation of the policy can be found on the Junior Gold page of bowl.com.



# Example

- 1:4 Ratio
- 7 Entries @ \$50 = \$350 in entry fees
- \$350 entry fee – \$200 to NPJG = \$150 remain
- NOW, second place finisher can pay the additional \$50 to qualify for the North Pointe Junior Gold Championships



# Premier Events

- 2010-11
  - Junior Gold berths, scholarship money and stipend money was all together.
  - Athlete would forfeit Junior Gold berth if he/she won a Premier Event.
- 2011-12
  - Junior Gold berth, stipend and scholarship money are considered separate awards.
  - If an athlete already has won a berth into NPJG Championships and wins a second event, the athlete is awarded the 1<sup>st</sup> place stipend and scholarship (if applicable); the Junior Gold berth would go to the next eligible USBC Junior Gold athlete.



# Important Qualifier Information

- Handbook
  - League and Tournament Books will be separate
  - U15 Finalist Report
  - U20 Finalist Report
- North Pointe Junior Gold Spots
  - National tournament may fill up
    - Spot is not secured without payment




# Important Qualifier Information


- One month (30 days) prior to the event you must submit payment for the spot
- Within 15 days of the event concluding we must have your post event report and finalist report from tournament
- Please have these forms filled out COMPLETELY


