

2010 USBC WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIPS EL PASO

AVERAGE VERIFICATION FORM

TEAM CAPTAINS: It is the responsibility of each team captain to provide verification of the averages for all team members participating in the 2010 USBC Women's Championships. This will ensure your team and bowlers are assigned to the correct division and help to speed up the check-in process.

Failure to use a correct average that has not been properly verified shall result in disqualification of the score and forfeiture of all tournament winnings.

- When a bowler's current 21 game average as of Jan. 1, 2010 is 10 or more pins higher than the previous season's average, that average must be used. = rule 319a-2

DIVISION STRUCTURE: Diamond = Singles & All-Events =180 & above Doubles = 360 & above Team = 900 & above
Ruby = Singles & All-Events =179 - 150 Doubles = 359 - 300 Team = 899 - 750
Sapphire = Singles & All-Events =149 & less Doubles = 299 & less Team = 749 & below

- Bowlers must report any re-rate or adjustment to average from any other tournament or event.
- Bowlers who have qualified for \$600 or more in any tournament or event during the 12 months prior to participation in the 2010 Women's Championships must attach a report showing actual score bowled and money won.

TO PROPERLY VERIFY AVERAGES:

- Submit BOWL.com average profile print out – Signature from the association manager is not required.
- Association manager must verify the 2008-2009 highest yearbook average of 21 or more games for each entrant listed on the form below, or submit pages copied from the association yearbook.
- Bowlers lacking a 2008-2009 season average must use their highest average from the current season as of January 1, 2010, based on 21 or more games. Please provide association manager verification or submit the first league sheet published after December 31, 2009.
- If an entrant has no 2008-2009 average or January 1, 2010 average, the highest 2009-2010 USBC winter average as of the date of participation, based on 21 games or more, must be used. Bowlers most recent league sheet to date of participation in the tournament is required as proof of current average.

SPORT BOWLING AVERAGES: Bowlers that have a USBC Sport League Average and a standard league average shall use the higher of the two averages. Any bowler who has only a USBC Sport League average must use his/her adjusted Sport League average determined by utilizing the Average Adjustment Scale available on BOWL.com or in USBC Playing Rules. = rule 202a
